Your paper must include:

- a thesis statement in the first paragraph
- at least three sources, one of which must be a book other than your textbook (although you may access Wikipedia to gain general information about your subject, this may NOT be used as one of your sources).
- a works cited page (use the MLA citation method as taught in Mrs. Rozgowski's class.)
- The rubric sheet with items circled
- Completed checklist
- The rough draft will be turned in again with the final.

Your paper must be:

- between two and three pages, typed.
- in MLA format: 12-point font, Times New Roman, double-spaced, 1-inch margins, paragraphs indented to ½ inch (or five spaces)
- neat, well-organized, informative, and error-free
